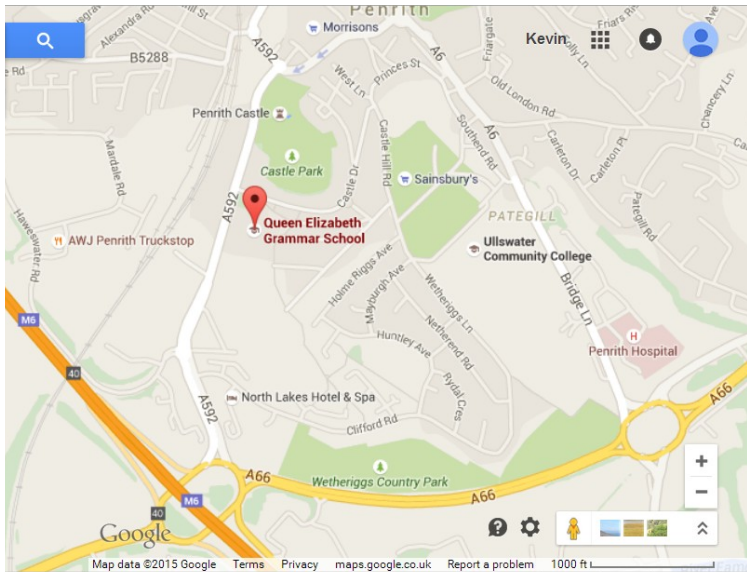

**Format**

The tournament organiser will explain any special arrangements for the competition on the day. It should be assumed that all the normal rules of chess apply unless otherwise stated. All decisions of the organiser relating to the event and its conduct are final.  
 The event organiser is enhanced DBS checked on behalf of Cumbria Chess Association; however, volunteers may not be.  
 Parents are responsible for their children outside of the chess-playing areas.  
**Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the school site.**
