
Parking and Disabled Users



GRADING

January 2018 ECF grades will be used. Players not in possession of a current ECF grade must state their last published grade, and the year to which it applied. Players with no official grading must give evidence in writing of their playing strength and all their latest chess playing results. If in doubt, please check before entering, as non-disclosure of material facts may lead to disqualification.

Closing date for postal entries postmarked MONDAY 11th JUNE 2018 - Late entries are subject to a surcharge of £3. **On-line entries** taken until **FRIDAY 15th June 6 p.m.**

DONATIONS:- Donations towards the running of the congress are greatly appreciated

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWALS: These must be received by the organisers in writing by 14th June 2018. Deductions of £2 are made from refunds.

HALF POINT BYE: A bye may be taken in Rounds 1, 2, 3 or 4 provided that this is indicated on the entry form. If you wish to withdraw at any stage, please let the controllers know.

RATE OF PLAY: 40 moves in 1 hour 40 minutes, after which each player has a further 20 minutes to finish the game. Swiss System of pairings.

DISPUTES: FOR ALL DISPUTES THE CHIEF CONTROLLER'S DECISION IS FINAL.

DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZES:- Prizes will be presented as soon after the conclusion of the final session of play as possible. The organisers reserve the right to re-distribute any other prize won by a competitor who has won or shared a main prize.

TRANSFER OF ENTRY:-The organisers reserve the right to transfer to another section a player whose grading or known performance is different from that stated on the player's entry form. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
